NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, in the Township of Hazlet, County of Monmouth as follows;

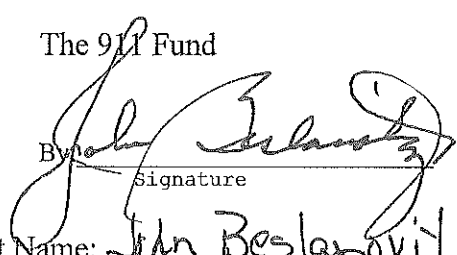
- (1) This Resolution shall serve as the authority for the Fire District to dispose of the property referenced in the attached list in accordance with New Jersey Statute.

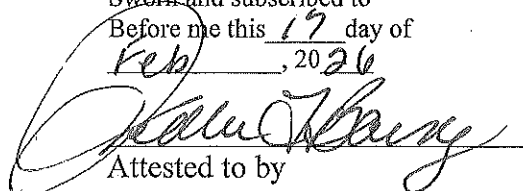

Who We Are, What We Do:

Created in the aftermath of September 11th, 2001, the 911 FUND was conceived by former members of the Fire Department of the City of New York (FDNY). All of our efforts are voluntary and unpaid, and the 911 FUND was born from the personal, hard-won experience and first-hand knowledge of New York City firefighters and emergency personnel, all of the founding members worked on September 11th at the World Trade Center.

As we watched brother firefighters commit their efforts, and in 343 cases their lives, to the rescue of 25,000 innocent civilians, we became convinced of the need to enhance our systems of emergency management and preparedness, and to share our skills and lessons-learned domestically with friends and allies the world over.

Ever since September 11th, we have worked to acquire fire trucks, ambulances and related equipment, then to donate it, along with training, as part of a continuing effort to build preparedness, reduce risk, enhance civilian safety, and minimize property loss from fire and other types of disasters. 100% of the training and equipment that we provide is given free-of-charge to firefighters and emergency first responders.

Service, solidarity, fraternity, brotherhood, a willingness to accept risks and make sacrifices is the common bloodline of firefighters worldwide. Access to the training and equipment that we provide routinely means the difference between life and death, and it's our belief that these are gifts that keep on giving. The 911 Fund has grown and expanded its membership and list of instructors keeping true to the founding principles and purpose: while adhering to the best principles of American fire service and Emergency Medical Response.



The fund is currently additionally staffed by Emergency Personnel – both EMS and firefighters from all over the country including New York, New Jersey, Boston, and California. All members donate their time and skills free of charge to firefighters and emergency service workers internationally.

Where We Have Served To Date:

Our service to international paid and volunteer fire departments, emergency medical and other responders with a need - Whether it's a lack of training, equipment, or vehicles continues with your donations. Our goal is to support these proud brave men and women to the best of our ability. 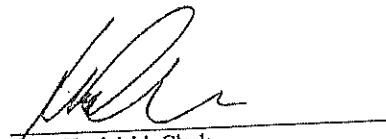
