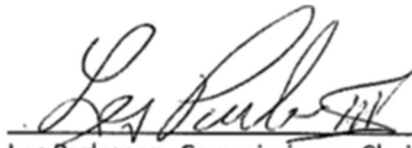
Michael Storcks- no address
